Besides, a total of 33 students have been appointed as Drug Inspectors in the Drug and Food Control Organization of J&K and 28 students as Pharmacists in the leading healthcare institutions of the state like SKIMS, SKIMS-MC, GMC-S etc, whereas 11 candidates have been employed as pharmacists in National Health Mission and 06 pass-outs have been employed as teachers in private educational institutions in Pharmacy.

Admissions for the first batch of B. Pharm. were made through entrance test conducted by All India Management Association in August, 2006 by the University of Kashmir independent of the entrance test conducted for other post-graduate programmes of the University. Entrance test has been conducted by the University of Kashmir since the session 2007-2008 on the basis of common entrance test. Admission to M.Pharm. on the basis of GPAT score for GPAT qualified candidates and University Entrance test for non-GPAT qualified candidates. Preference is given to GPAT qualified candidates who don't have to face a separate entrance test of the University of Kashmir.

- d) Completed the age of 17 years on or before the date of notification for the admission.
