Dear Sir,

As the Government of India is planning to roll out its ambitious scheme of Free Medicines For All in public health facilities, evaluating the scheme in future and identifying potential bottlenecks during the roll out would be of immense value to policy-makers and planners at both central and state level. Towards this end, a baseline assessment of the existing drug procurement and distribution system in the country would be required, if we were to compare the current scenario with mid-term scenario.

The baseline assessment is likely to be carried out in 8 states in India. However, for states which are already following the free medicine initiative (including Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Rajasthan), this would serve as a robust mid-line survey to assess the improvement in the past few years. It is in this regard, I am writing to seek your permission and department's clearance to conduct a baseline/mid-line survey to be coordinated by PHFI, which will be carried out in Jammu & Kashmir, as a joint work by PHFI and University of Kashmir (Dr. Geer Mohammad). The overall goal, specific objectives, detailed methodology, expected outcomes, funding source, etc. are outlined in the enclosed document. However, we would happy to provide any clarification, if required.

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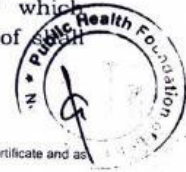
