

3.	Contingency Rs. 50,000/- to cover expenses for visa, airport, transfer, medical insurance

The University/College is, therefore, requested to arrange his air tickets from the nearest International airport in India to the capital of the country concerned and back (by excursion category for the whole sector or a part thereof, if available, otherwise by economy class shortest route) **directly by Air India and not by any other airline**.
